

EYBL Rules:

- The rules will be consistently enforced.
- The commissioner will have the final word, which is Jeff Rogers
- Rosters can no longer change tournament to tournament. Have to have one locked roster.
- Locked Roster will be in place for the Memorial Day tournament
- Player can only appear on one locked or unlocked roster
- No sharing players
- Limit to 15 names on the roster
- Can only change out 3 players for the first 2 tournaments
- You can not show up with anyone not on your roster, they will not be able to play
- NCAA rules including 3pt line
- No more than 3 players from outside your state to be eligible
- If a player gets hurt and can not play you can drop him off your frozen roster, but can not add him back in
- 16min halves
- 35 second shot clock
- College Refs 3 man crew
- 5 personal fouls
- Bonus 10 fouls
- Ties
 - Head to head
 - 3 way point system
 - Conference
- Has to be a consistent dress code for players and coaches
 - Coaches should wear slacks and EYBL polo
 - No shorts

- No hats
- No sweats

- Players should arrive in gym with appropriate attire. EYBL provided attire

- If your team is traveling and your flight is delayed and you miss a game you have to take the loss

- Make travel accordingly to give yourself enough time
 - Teams traveling longer time will be given later games
 - Game time is game time; if you are late it is a loss
 - No make up games next day or next tournament

- Can not combine teams in each state

- Prep School, 5th year, Senior Rule
No player who is currently classified as a senior can play in the league during the current season. This rule applies to all seniors, regardless of age. If they plan to reclassify now or after the school year or go to a prep school, they still cannot play in the league. All league players must have at least one year of high school eligibility remaining.
